Matters arising
conservation - Mr Shires reported that S.P. could be designated
this year but it was doubtful if the amended larger area
could be designated. It was agreed that a letter be sent
to Mr Scott thanking him for his talk and agreeing to
accept his suggestions as to the area to be designated,
also to request a list of cottages classed as ancient monuments
flowers for Mrs Janshend - the Secretary reported that
enquiries to friends had suggested it better to wait
until Mrs Janshend returned home. Since however she

was now spending a considerable time at home it was agreed that a token of appreciation be sent forthwith.

Yellow Lines Mrs Hibchi reported that the amended extension had been passed in Council & she hoped that the restriction would soon take place.

Mr Shires reported that the wire mesh in the pond had been cleaned.

Seepage & Silver St - Mrs Hibchi had delayed reporting these requests to the Prov. Engineer as the move to the new Municipal Bldgs. had been just effected and the Officers had been engaged on this. She would however write within the next few days. In connection with the pond, a hole had been discovered in the bridge.
