

Minutes of a Committee Meeting held on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June 1972  
at 3, Silver St, Mr Shires in the chair.

Apologies were received from Mr Hales

Matters Arising - The Pond Mr Shires read to the Committee a draft he had compiled concerning the summer stagnation of the pond. The Committee agreed that some way must be found of combatting this not only for reasons of health and amenity value, but to maintain the principles of Conservation. Regarding the provision of water in the summer, it was agreed that the matter be put to the Corporation, and that they be sounded as to their willingness to pay for the extra water required to maintain a constant flow. The Society would be willing to assist financially in installing a <sup>meter</sup> pump if necessary. Mr Lebschi considered it a pity that we

did not know exactly where we stood regarding Conservation Policy for the village. It was decided that a modified version of the draft be sent to the members of the Parks Committee; should the outcome be unfavourable we would then bring more pressure to bear in higher quarters and publicity wise. Notes on to Heavy Traffic The Committee was glad to note that in answer to our request the D.C. had placed one at the northern end of Plaistead on James Court - Mr Hetsche reported that the Constable since he had envisaged had not proved satisfactory in the proof, he had passed on the block to Mr Tanner for use in the Church Magazine. It was decided that a Sub Committee be formed consisting of Mrs Brown, Mr Cox, Mrs Morris & Mr Hetsche with the task of deciding on a suitable print.

Election of Officers Press Agent - this to be held jointly by Mrs Hetsche & Mrs Shires. Membership and Recruitment - Mr Fenner to continue.

Posters Mrs Brown offered the services of her daughter Alison to help in providing posters. Mr Preskley offered to make a dye-line print.
