

Minutes of a Committee Meeting held on Friday July 14th 72
at 3, Silver St, Mr Shires in the Chair.

Apologies from Mr & Mrs Brown and Mr Cox.

Matters Arising

The Pond It was reported that it had been decided on the Streets and Works Committee that the Corporation had agreed to pay for a supply of water and that a meter would be installed. It was thought that the cost of the meter and its installation would be somewhere in the region of £44. It was agreed the Secretary should negotiate a sum towards this cost, but not in excess of £20. The Secretary was asked to draw to the attention of the Bor. Eng's Dept the following points a) that the pond still leaked to at least the amount of 1000 galls per day. b) that the end of the pond be excavated to a depth of 1' thus holding more water & less likely to dry up. c) To ask that the meter be not installed on Water Board land, a) to ascertain who should be responsible for notifying the R.E. Dept when water needed to be turned on.

Hulworth Castle Visit

Correspondence had ensued but parties were not welcome on Saturday afternoons during the season. It was however intimated that parties might be welcome later on. The Secretary would endeavour to arrange a date in early autumn.

Tea on the lawn

Efforts had been made to contact Mrs Macdonald but without success. After much discussion it was agreed to hold an evening sizzle

Regarding the three Sub-Committees or Groups, of History, Conservation + Xmas Cards, the Chairman asked that progress reports be submitted at each Committee Meeting. He recommended that the Conservation Group look into the matter of Mrs Lupp's chapel. They should also assess the village as to what changes might be made as to what is detrimental.

Mr Hutschi mentioned the state of the White Horse, the Chairman promised to contact the Osnyth Society as to how matters stood regarding cleaning.

Juline Programme

The Chairman promised to contact Mr Waite as to his showing films of the village. Nov 18th was suggested as the date for the annual Social. Mr Hutschi suggested that the Grahams might feel the entertainment appt.

Collection It was suggested that a collection box be placed in a strategic position, at non fee paying events, but it was decided that it would be preferable not to do so apart from perhaps the meetings held in the Mission Hall.

Ducks - Mr Saunders reported that often the ducks queued outside the gate to go into their pen, Mrs Squibbs had opened it for them on several occasions.
