

Minutes of a Committee held on Friday Aug 18<sup>th</sup> 1972  
at 3, Silver St. Mr Shires in the Chair.  
Apologies from Mrs Morris & Mr Hackett Jones.  
The Minutes of the previous meeting were read  
and adopted.

### Matters Arising

The Pond The Secretary reported Borough Engineer plans for a water meter and the Council's thanks for the contribution towards the expense.

White Horse The Secretary reported that arrangements were in hand for its cleaning.

History Group Mr Hutschi reported that he had written Colonel Weld, and all records etc. had been handed over to the County Archivist. Col. Weld is the lord of Sutton Poyntz, & Hutschi reported his visits to various houses connected with the Poyntz Family. The Chairman suggested that a simple guide be put together by the History Group for the use of visitors.

Conservation Sub-Committee reported that they had met, had set the wheels in motion, but had nothing to report at present.

### Xmas Cards

Mr Hutschi showed 4 copies of aerial views but did not feel these were suitable. He was trying to contact an artist who had designed a card for another village.

### Future Programme

The South Hall had been booked for the annual

It was agreed that Mrs Morris, <sup>Mrs Hunt</sup> be asked at a later date whether they would be willing to supervise the refreshment side.

Barbecue 16<sup>th</sup> Sept. - this had been arranged for Nov. 11<sup>th</sup>.

Mr Fenton reported that the Barbecue Machine would be available. It was agreed that wine & beer be provided & that if necessary food should be subsidised. Mr Hutsch & Mr Nicklen had kindly offered homemade wine, Mr Fenton beer, and food would be ordered by Mrs Morris. The Chairman stated that he had not yet been able to contact Mr Waiters - his films of the village.

Regarding the A.G.M. it was suggested that Mr Hutsch might show some of his slides relating to the village & the Payntz Family. It was decided to meet at Cob Cottage on Sept 24<sup>th</sup> at 7.30 p.m. to look at them. Since Mr Hutsch had a great number & would welcome the Committee's comments as to which were most worthy of showing.

#### Any other Business

It was agreed that a watch be kept on the new Town & Country Planning Act which was in process, also developments approaching in the village such as Sutton Rd & Weendon.

Members in Sutton Court houses wished to plant more trees in their immediate vicinity & the Secretary promised to ascertain whether this would be allowed by the Planning Authority.
