

Minutes of a Committee Meeting held on Friday
Jan 19th 1943 at 3, Silver St. Mr Shure in
the Chair.

and Mrs Morris.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read
and adopted.

Matters Arising

A vote of thanks was proposed to Mr Presley and
Mr Denton for the preparing and organising
of Benjie Night; to Mrs Brown & Mrs Haveland
for the excellent annual social. It was
agreed that a letter of thanks be sent to
Mrs Haveland. A profit of £8.51 was made
on the Social.

Xmas Cards These had proved most popular
1000 had already been sold, and a further
200 were almost sold out. It was agreed
to order 200 more.

Footpaths - Miss Pitman was quite willing
to remove her obstruction. Mr Saunders
deplored the fact that many visitors were
unaware of correct paths & tended to
wander. He would appreciate more
signs. It was wondered whether wooden

notices could be used when necessary. It was urged that the Society issue a pamphlet on footpaths stating distances. Mr Denton offered to run these off & Mr Bullen undertook to obtain the necessary maps from County Hall for this purpose.

Lulworth Castle Visit - The Secretary to write proposing dates in March & April.

The Pond - The secretary was asked to check up on water meter etc to ensure that the water supply would be ready for the high season. She also would endeavour to arrange for dredging to be carried out, & would once again remind the Corporation of the Seepage. The untidy island was discussed but it was agreed that this be left in abeyance until the water supply was working.
