### Matters Arising

Footpaths Mr Bullen reported on his visits to County Hall and produced a map for inspection. The footpaths required were discussed. Regarding signposts Mr Brown, Mr Saunders and Mr Hunt would co-operate to produce one required in White Horse lane.

Pond The Secretary reported on the summer water situation and the Borough Engineer's proposal re. the Water Meter. The Water Board were proving unco-operative on the original suggestion.

It was proposed therefore that a Corporation Foreman inspect the pond twice weekly and when necessary turn on the water supply. The Committee did not feel too happy about this proposal and suggested that a letter be sent suggesting this be left to one of the members, although they would accept the suggested scheme temporarily.
