

Minutes of the A.C.M. May 18th 1974 held at Scutt Hall.

- 1) There were no apologies.
- 2) The minutes of the 1973 A.C.M. were read and adopted.
- 3) Matters arising. The £20 has not been paid to the Council due to our dissatisfaction on the condition of the pond.
- 4) The Secretary's report was read and adopted.
- 5) Treasurer reported a balance of £75.70.
- 6) The Chairman in his report mentioned the pond & also that a request has been put in to have Plaister regarded as a built up area and a 30 mph speed limit. He then outlined the hard work which had been put into the production of the Trumpet Major which was to be enacted after the A.C.M.
- 7) Election of officers & committee were announced.
- 8) Mr Litchie the incoming Chairman wanted the village to retain its character & preserve its tranquility. He was very much in favour of trying to set up a Preston conservation Society.
- 9) At this stage Mrs Martin presented to the Society a significant banner which she had made & was thanked by Mrs Shree. This brought the A.C.M. to a close.
