#### Matters Arising.

Lecture This was held on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> March in the Mission Hall and the talk was given by Mr. Durston on the history of Portland. Sixty members & friends attended.

Extension to Smithy Cottage, Plaisters Lane.

Mrs Hitschi reported that Mr. R. Reid, the new owner of Smithy Cottage had applied to Weymouth & Portland Borough Council Planning Committee for permission to build an extension to his property. The Committee examined the plans & raised no objections.

Double Garage at 'Little Acorns', Puddledock Lane.

Mrs Hitschi reported that Mr. Birch had applied for planning permission to build a double garage at the above address. No objections were raised at the meeting and the Committee decided that as this property is in the Conservation Area, the proposal would be advertised in the press & any neighbour wishing to do so, could object.

Mrs. Hitschi presented to the Committee, a copy of the Town & Country Amenities Act, 1974, setting out the new Regulations regarding Conservation Areas.

Electricity & Telephone Wires in the Village

Mr. G. Shines read a report prepared by Mrs Shines on her consultation with Mr. Greenwood of the P.O. Telephones Dept. regarding the tidy up of the wires around the pond.

### Fish for Pond.

Mrs. Hitschi was asked to contact Mr. Saunille of the Weymouth & Portland Borough Council to ask if it is now possible to return the fish to the pond.
