

Minutes of a Committee Meeting held at 1, Old Bincombe Lane  
on Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup> June<sup>1980</sup>. Mr. L. Ingham in the Chair.

Apologies: Mr. McEachern and Mr. Saunders.

Apologies were received from the Langton Herring Action Group against Nuclear Power Station, a member of which was unable to speak at this meeting but hopes to address the Committee at a future date.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

#### Matters Arising.

- a) The Council have been informed about the leaning tree by the pond.
- b). The long walk has been arranged for Sunday, 27<sup>th</sup> July.
- c) The summer dance will not be arranged this year.
- d) The Mission Hall has been booked for 16<sup>th</sup> Sept. for Coffee Morning.
- e). The Village Notice Board should be renovated this winter.
- f). Potholes in Sutton Rd have been filled in but not those in Mission Hall lane and Mans vess lane.
- g). The corner at Mill House has been topped satisfactorily.  
A telegram of congratulation was sent to Mrs. Hutchins as the new Mayor of Weymouth and Portland. (cost £3)

#### Planning.

- ① Purbeck Lodge. The Society has no objection to the application for a lounge extension.
- ② Site West of Beggars Roost: The Society had suggested that a bungalow would be more suitable in this position but as there is a house on the adjacent side the Council have given permission for the building of a house.

③. 66, Sutton Rd. The building of the house is in progress.  
④. Erection of shed for indoor riding school. The Planning Sub-Committee of the Society met to discuss this proposal and was very sympathetic towards the case. The horse breeding should be encouraged as it is a village business in keeping with the countryside. However, owing to the huge size of the building it would obstruct the view up the valley. Unfortunately another site could not be suggested. The proposal was rejected by the Council.

After a meeting with Miss Pitman, Mr Ingham agreed that the sub-committee should go again to look at the site, after Miss Pitman has staked out the position.

⑤. 83, Sutton Rd. The council has given permission for the front of the bungalow to be extended.

#### Summer Activities

- b). A power was passed round the Committee advertising 'Music in Gardens' sent by Mrs. Brown of Cobb Cottage.
- c). Offers are still required for tea on the lawn.

#### Report of Membership Cards

Any other Business. A number of complaints have been received about the bad state of the pond. Wan will

make enquiries about it.

Complaints have been made about some of the footpaths being blocked. It was decided that the Society should not become involved, as other organisations eg. Ramblers had been dealing with it.
