

Minutes of a Committee Meeting held on Thursday, 19th March, 1981, at 2, Sutton Court house. Mr. L. Ingham in the Chair.

Apologies: None.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Matters arising:

- ① The Pond: The leaks are being attended to. Mr. Ingham will ring Mr. Glaysher to check up on progress.
- ② The Mill: A copy of the minutes of the Open Meeting has been typed up. Mr. Ingham will sign them and they will be filed.
- ③ Ruddledock lane: A letter has been received from the Chief Executive saying that Mr. Ingham's letter has been passed on to the Chief Planning Officer for comment. If the reply to this letter states that Weymouth Council can do nothing about the situation, copies of the Chairman's letter will be sent to the Preston Councilors seeking their support. A copy will also be sent to Dorset County Council.

Because Sunnyfields' residents, together with the future residents of the new houses being built in Ruddledock lane pay their rates to Weymouth Borough Council, and all services come from Weymouth, it is the latter's responsibility to make a safe way through from Sunnyfields to Preston while the new building is taking place. This would be a temporary job and Weymouth

Council should not opt out of this responsibility and pass the issue back to Dorset County Council. Puddledock lane will ultimately come under Dorset Co. Council. If any of the above buildings proved on to Puddledock lane, legally the road should be made up. However, none of these properties actually do.

- (4) 83, Sutter Rd: The Chairman contacted Mr. Morris who said that there was no chance at the moment of Sutter Rd being widened. Mr. Ingham will ask if a site meeting might be arranged between a representative of the Borough Engineer and Committee members of the S.P.S. to discuss the problem. This meeting would then be on Weymouth Council records and something might be done in the future.

The sign "Predestinians on Rd" might make motorists more aware of the dangers on this road.

It has been arranged that a member of Weymouth Camera Club (Paddy at Nestons) will give a film show


