

MINUTES

of Committee Meeting on 25 November 1987 at 7.30 pm. at 2 Suttles Close.

1. Minutes - of meeting on 8 October 1987 read and signed as correct.

2. Matters arising (see Planning and Social Activities)

3. Chairman's Report.

Mrs Litschi mentioned that she had been reliably informed that the Stables, Land and Bungalow are advertised for sale by estate agents in Blandford. She referred to the S.S. order applying to the bungalow, making it an integral part of the Stables property. The Planning Department of W.D.C. are aware of the advertisement. The pigs had now gone from the stable yard, but slurry has run from their pen to the stream by Serrany brookage; the District E.H.O. is aware of this - the matter will be reported to the Chief E.H.O.

4. Secretary's Report.

(a) Telephone Kiosk. Arising from the June meeting, the Secretary wrote to Bt. Telecom. They replied to the effect that this kiosk is not 30 years old and not therefore "preserved". The W.D.C. Planning Officer had been approached; he accepted what Bt. Tel said but hoped they would re-consider in view of the Society's feelings.

(b) W.C.S. A list of future events was received.
A note on these will be exhibited in our notice frame.

(c) Visit to the Village by Friends of Red House Museum.

The Secretary has assisted this organisation in making a visit to Suttles Bogux in June and Mr Litschi will give them members a talk on the village & show them round. The members will have coffee at the Springhead.

5. Financial report. Mrs Wilkinson reported (via the Secretary) that £109.25 had been paid to the printers for the greeting cards (1000) and just over £30 had so far been received for cards sold.

6. Planning Matters.

(i) Preston Rectory. Mr Knight said that the P.C.C. had been informed that the rectory was likely to continue to be used as such for at least another five years.

(ii) 2 Waterworks Cottages. A planning application had been submitted to the Council and comments forwarded to the Planning Dept as decided on 8 October.

(iii) Weymouth Plan - Consultative Document. This has been circulated by the Council, for comments by January. The Secretary read sections relating to Seltton Poyntz, which appeared to members present to be reasonable. The document will be circulated to the Committee.

7. Social Events

(a) Talk on 18 November. Some 30 people attended. £5 will be sent to Mr Baker [Note: he asked that it be sent to R.S.P.B.].

(b) Musical Evening on 21 January. Coffee and biscuits will be served.

(c) Sam Dance. The Chairman hoped to arrange this with Mr. G. King (the caller) within about a fortnight.

(d) Possible Carol Evening. The Secretary will discuss this with Mrs Presley and the Springhead.

(e) Visit to Police Station. It was agreed, on the recommendation of A.G.M. of the Donnelly's contact, that the visit should be to Dorchester, possibly in February. Matt Rosekilly will follow this up.

f. A.G.M. It was decided that only coffee & biscuits should be provided by the Society, as a bar will be available.
