

### MINUTES

of Committee Meeting on MONDAY 13 JUNE 1988 at Little Acorns.  
Mrs J. Firth, in the chair. Apologies from Mrs Loveland.

1. Minutes of Meeting on 10 May 1988 read and approved.

2. Matters arising.

(a) Footpaths. Representations made as decided on 10 May.  
As regards the footpath behind Mission Hall Lane, it was  
decided to clear the brambles and debris, commencing at the  
Plains Lane end. The Borough Engineer will be contacted  
by the Secretary and the Mrs Bryant (adjacent) informed  
before the work commences.

Mr. Litchie said she would speak to the Footpaths Office about disturbance of the signs by White Horse Lane.

(b) Rats. Some action had been taken by the Environmental Health Dept, although there is still evidence of infestation. Individual villagers had also taken action. The Chief E.H.O. had suggested that the ducks be kept off the pond permanently - bread fed to them accumulates and encourages the rats. The Committee did not agree to this suggestion - the ducks have been a feature of the village for 20 years or so, and rodent infestation was only sporadic. Councillor B. Ellis, new Chairman of the Environmental Health Ctte, will be acquainted of the position.

It was agreed that little notices be placed round the pond asking people not to feed the ducks.

(c) Christmas Card. The Secretary reported that Jatts, Ltd, printers of old receipt cards, would now only produce cards individually wrapped in cellophane, cost £170 per 1000 + VAT. Enquiries of Judges Ltd. revealed their prices commencing at £92 per 1000 + VAT but a minimum order of 2500 was required. The Ctte was not prepared to accept either of these. The Secretary said there were one or two other firms whom he would approach and Mrs Litchie will contact Mr Barnett of Norwich Press.

3. Marusei's Report. - Bank balance was £200.39; cash in hand £20.28 and N.S. Mc £1179.59. Mrs Wilkinson said £60 in cash had been received prior to the meeting - about £40 was, however, handed to her at this meeting.

#### 4. Planning Matters

VADP Developments Ltd. This company had invited owners around the 'wedge' to meet them individually to discuss plans for possible development. They said they now owned the land.

Mr Birch said a few of those contacted had told him they were not interested in dealing with VADs. It was decided to update the Chief Planning Officer and remind him of the assurances he and the Chairman of the Planning Committee gave at our AGM about development there.

5. Social Activities. Nothing needed to be discussed until the next meeting.

6. Other Matters

(a) Water in the Road + Stream. Representations will be made to Loeser Water for water to be run through much more often than once in three or four weeks during the summer.

(b) Trees in Old Biscoube Lane. Nothing seems to have happened so far; Mrs Litschi would make enquiries of the Council.
