

MINUTES of Special Meeting of the Committee

i. The Barbeque

Mr Birch said that an important family gathering in Devon over the weekend 9/10 September would prevent him from being at the

barbeque. Two members of the Committee had agreed to look after the food. The date (10 Sept) was proved difficult for two other members. After considerable discussion, it was decided to fix the barbeque ~~for~~ to 17th September.

Don Birch produced a schedule of requirements for running the barbeque and suggested food. The "requirements" were accepted in principle (including adequate publicity in the Echo) and the food agreed apart from there being no barbequed chicken, on health grounds. Hire of the jazz band at a cost of up to £80 was agreed. Stalls were to be plants & produce and books - no cake stall or such.
