

## MINUTES

of Committee Meeting on 19 April 1995 at 7.30pm. at The Old Stables. Tony Baker in the chair; apologies from Richard Meek and Maureen Morris (Suzie Bebban absent).

1. Membership. Members of the Committee for 1994/5 were named.

2. Election of Officers. Those in office last year were re-elected. Peter Jones will "shadow" the Chairman on social activities. Joyce Litschii said she would wish to be more involved.

3. Matters arising.

(a) The plaque is in position on the former Court House wall.

(b) Britain-in-House. In Suzie Bebban's absence, there was a brief discussion on an entry. The sub-committee should meet soon.

It was agreed that we accept Maureen Bond's suggestion that the S.T.S. competition be extended to the Cubs and entries can be in any form (painting, collage etc.). Mrs Mabel Manning and Sitt George Shires were suggested as judges, and around £10 agreed as the cost of prizes. The Chairman will pursue this with Mrs Bond.

(c) Water in Sutton Road. Mrs Litschii contacted the Environment Office, as a result of which the problem was remedied.

(d) Hills, Huddlesdon Lane/Sutton Road. These had been ~~eradicated~~ by Brian Huddley although odd branches etc remained. It is important that the area is cleared before the B-in-B judging and Ron Rich undertook to speak to Mr Huddley to clear up.

(e) Rubbish dumping. The Environment Dept. had confirmed to Ron Rich that only <sup>in</sup> adopted roads can the council clear rubbish and then only up to a metre from the edge of the road a path.

4. Matters arising from the A.C.M.

(a) Traffic calming. Sutton Rd/Marshers Lane. It was decided

to renew the representations of 1992 to the Borough Council.

Ian Jones suggested that contact be made with the local police.

(b) Double footpath - Sutton road. Again renewed representations will be made to the Borough Council regarding a footpath on the rise on the East side of Sutton road. (It was recognised that because of the closure of the old school, use of Sutton road by schoolchildren was less).

c. Footpaths converted to bridlepaths? The Chairman has discussed this with the Dorset County footpaths officer who is unaware of any such conversion anywhere in his area. The member who raised it has been informed accordingly.

#### 5. The Millennium Fund.

The Chairman mentioned the purpose of this fund and our letters to Wessex Archaeology and Stewex Water about another "dig" in Sutton Ledges, following the important finds in 1993/4.

It was also agreed that thought be given to possible development of the Sutton down to update facilities, and provision of children's and other facilities in adjacent land; the Head will be asked for their comments. The church authorities will of course be involved.

#### 6. Chairman's Report.

(a) New tram route: Tony Hugler referred to recent notices in the press regarding compulsory acquisition of much land in and around Littleton road, Diaconage etc. The Committee decided to inform the Department of Transport of the Society's opposition to this route, with the M.P. and Dorset C.C. being also informed.

(b) Withdrawal of applications: The Chairman reported that recent applications to WBC about the car-park behind the Branch and the bungalow off Tiduledock Lane had been withdrawn.

(c) Support for functions: Tony Hugler hoped all members of the Committee with their spouses would endeavour to support Society's functions; this was endorsed.

7. Secretary's report.

- (a) Division of Village for Subs etc. Arrangements agreed, subject to Peter Jones and Richard Backwell agreeing division of Blairstown Lane.
- (b) Motionery, the Committee agreed to the Secretary purchasing note paper (and a small quantity of matching envelopes) from Ian Jeffries, recently set up a small business.

8. Social Activities.

- (i) Quiz night. - Only sparsely attended but enjoyable. No further draws will be arranged.
- (ii) "Teas on the Lawns". - Arrangements for 29 July in Old Blairstown Lane were accepted by residents concerned.
- (iii) Summer Walk - possible walks for 15 June were discussed. Richard Backwell will decide actual route etc. urgently.  
All these and other relevant items will appear in a Newsletter to be issued as soon as possible, before the subs are collected.
- (iv) Future activities. In addition to those mentioned at the last meeting, a talk by Bryan Bassidy, M.E.P., on "facts and figures about Europe" was agreed.

9. Next Meeting - 30 May 1978. Simon Gaubler to be asked if we could meet at Woytling.
