1. A letter from S. Embrey on behalf of objectors to development at the church (car park application) and hall etc by the church building, seeking the society's support. The V.C.C. has in fact withdrawn the application, following consultation. As regards accommodation, the V.C.C. is understood to be considering a variety of options. It was decided to inform Mr Embrey that nothing remains to be discussed over the car park and that the society is not going to comment at present on any proposed development, leaving it to individuals who may wish to comment.
2. Britain-in-Bloom. Simon is unable to undertake much work on B.I.B. in view of many other commitments. He and Dorothy will, however, attend to the cart by the pub and will be making a video or a cassette of the village through the year in readiness for 1996. It was agreed that the corner of Butterfield and Huddlesford Lane must be cleared, possibly by paying Andrew Kissiter for the use of his transpat, and the verge opposite needs attention. A "holding" letter will be sent to villagers but urging them to do as well as last year.
