Minutes of CB meeting of CB Committee held on 2nd December 1998 at 'The Mill' MP in CB chair.

1) Apologies - Alvin Simpson

2) As this was an extra meeting called by the Chairman to consider a particular issue the reading of CB minutes of CB meeting of 17th November were deferred to the meeting scheduled for 19th Jan 99.

7) Valleys appraisal

The Chairman explained that he was anxious for CB Committee to make a decision on whether to proceed with CB plans for a valleys appraisal similar to the one carried out at Milt. Abbas which had been discussed at previous meetings.

Additional information had been obtained by PJ - a booklet entitled 'Helping you to understand your Community' - and this had been distributed to members to help them in the decision process.

Following a lengthy discussion the Chairman asked each member to opt for or against carrying out the appraisal. The general consensus was against the scheme and it was agreed that the Society would not undertake a valleys appraisal similar to the one carried out at Milt. Abbas. However there was strong support for action to be taken to respond to CB original request

from the Chief Planning Officer for a village input in time for the preparation of the ^{revision of the} national structure plan by WPBC.

It was agreed that a small sub-committee of MP, RM, PJ would prepare a draft scheme for consideration at the meeting of 19th January. Details would be circulated to members in advance of the meeting.

At the Chairman's request the following items were considered.

(a) The cart at the Springfield. MP explained that it was now in a very poor state of repair and suggested that it should be handed over to the landlord. S. E. was asked to speak to Peter Small about this.

A further suggestion that the back plate of the cart with the Sander's name should be preserved and hung in the hall room was strongly supported.

(b) Millennium Group. It was reported that Alan Simpson could no longer represent the Society on the village working party. Robert Backwell volunteered to take his place. It was also agreed that the Society would undertake any printing of newsletters/questionnaires that the working party produced.

The meeting closed at 8-40pm. Thanks were given to MM & DM for their hospitality.

The next meeting on 19th Jan. will now take place at Tony Bayler's house.
