1. Apologies P Riley
2. The minutes of the meeting of 11<sup>th</sup> October 04 were read and approved.
3. Matters arising
  - a. Action Continues –re JS to remind Alan or Les Jolliffe re supply and siting of large stone(s) on which to mount a single plaque for the millennium trees. He has promised to deliver and erect it when he next has suitable equipment. JS has given copy of letter to WW to AJ which indicates the position for the stones.

9. AOB


- a. JS noted that Norman Brown had erected a No Parking sign at the Old Coach House with the agreement of the Society (and the owners of the property).
