 Sutton Poyntz Society amend constitution to become a neighbourhood forum in the absence of a Parish Council

Where Are We Up To?

27 May 2016

Neighbourhood Area application sent to Borough Council

10 June TO 5 August 2016

Formal public consultation period for Neighbourhood Area

20 September 2016

 Borough Council approve intention to form a Neighbourhood Plan under the Localism Act 2011

Where Are We Up To ?

17 May 2016

• First meeting of volunteer Steering Group (consists of members and non-members of Sutton Poyntz Society, second home owners, land owners) – meetings to be open and held first Tuesday of the month, 7.30pm

October 2016

- Technical training undertaken by Steering Group
- Second newsletter and first consultation survey distributed and two open days held

Where Are We Up To?

November 2016

• Analysis of feedback (75 forms and 400 post it comments produced by 66 visitors)

February 2017

 Brian Wilson and Associates appointed consultants to the Steering Group

 Consultant and Steering Group meet and use the consultation analysis to produce first draft Vision statement and primary objectives for the Neighbourhood Plan

3rd March 2017

• First public feedback of survey results at village coffee

March to April 2017

• Draft vision and objectives (sub-groups start work)

May to August 2017

- Further public survey and consultation
- Gather evidence plan and develop policies and options

September 2017

• Define and consult on Policies

October to November 2017

• Draft the Neighbourhood Plan

December 2017 to January 2018

 Strategic Environmental Assessment screening by Borough Council

February to March 2018

- Formal consultation on plan by Neighbourhood Forum
- Finalise Consultation Statement and produce Basic Conditions Statement

April 2018

• Revise and submit Neighbourhood Plan to Local Authority for examination

Remainder of 2018

- Local authority checks Plan documents and organises its examination
- Public Referendum on adoption of the Neighbourhood Plan
